Learning Area + Focus	Ideas, Links (max. 2 per learning area)
<u>Reading</u>	<b>E- Platform-</b> continue reading either the book you have at home or one you have chosen from E-Platform. This is an online library of 1000 ebooks, ranging from picture books to advanced, fiction to nonfiction. It can be accessed via the App Store - search "eplatform by wheelers" or at <a href="https://hcs.wheelers.co">https://hcs.wheelers.co</a> . Search for Hastings Christian Library, then either browse or search the books. Initially, if you click on a book, you will be prompted to register.
